

## Concept of safety and hygiene

for guided tours at Memorial Denkort Bunker Valentin (Status: 26/08/2021)

Regulations on safety and hygiene:

- The 3-G (short for German: genesen, geimpft, getestet – recovered, vaccinated, tested) rule applies at Memorial Denkort Bunker Valentin: visitors who have recovered, been vaccinated or tested from Covid19 can visit the memorial and book educational formats.
- Guided tours take place only in the depot part of the bunker and on the outside area. Until further notice, guided tours do not cover the information centre and the exhibition.
- For public tours, the maximum number of participants is 10. Children under 6 years of age are not included. A maximum of 20 people can take part in an individual group tour. The person registering is independently responsible for compliance with the 3G rule in the entire group. If new legal regulations will be published, we reserve the right to react to the specific changes at short time and to adjust the group sizes.

- According to the regulation on the determination of contact persons, we are obliged to collect your personal data before the start of guided tours. You can send us your data during the booking process on our website or use the Luca app and the Guest Bremen app on site. Your personal data are only collected for this purpose. They are kept for four weeks and are only processed to the health office on its request. Please gather at the information centre 15 minutes before the begin of the guided tour.
- Please register early at our staff members in the information centre. For public guided tours, regular prices are 7€ per person, reduced prices are 3€ per person. For individual group tours, the price is 70€ for tours in German language and 80€ for tours in foreign languages. Please pay to our staff members at the information desk.

- Before or after a guided tour, participants can explore the information centre and exhibition on their own. The following hygiene measures apply in the information centre:

A maximum of 20 people are allowed in the information centre at the same time.

Please pay attention to the counting system at the entrances, which indicates whether you are allowed to enter. Please pay attention to the general hygiene rules and follow the instructions of our staff.

- You can rent multimedia guides at the information desk. Please use your own headphones or the integrated speakers of the device.
- **Meeting place for guided tours is at the benches near the main entrance of the information centre.**
- During the guided tour, participants and tour guide are obliged to cover their mouth and nose with a FFP2 mask or simple surgical mask.
- The rule of minimum distances applies during the whole course of the guided tour. All participants are asked to keep a distance of 1.5 meters to each other.
